services platform. FogChain also added the ability to capture mobile objects and elements to build an object repository for functional mobile automation. Newgate Communications was appointed as PR advisor to FogChain.

Business activity in March was focused mainly around the continued development of Quilmont, RadJav, and the App Monitoring products in to a unified platform called Trident. Efforts were also made on identifying further merger and acquisition targets in the industry.

Essentially, this new update enables the automated analysis, recognition, and logging of web objects and native iOS and Android mobile objects in an application, replacing the typical time-consuming approach of manual inspector tools.
